A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA AUTHORIZING A PURCHASE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 TO PACIFIC REDWOOD PRODUCTS, LLC, TO PURCHASE MATERIALS FOR THE SCENIC PATHWAY BARRIER RAILS PROJECT

WHEREAS, constructed in the 1980s, the wooden barrier rails along the Scenic Pathway have exceeded their lifespan and are in a state of deterioration; and

WHEREAS, in June 2021, the City Council approved the FY 2021/22 Capital Improvement Program which included an appropriation of \$50,000 for the Scenic Pathway Barrier Rails Project, funded by Measure C; and

WHEREAS, Carmel Cares, an official City support group, working collaboratively with the City, submitted design plans for the repairs, which were approved by the Community Planning & Building and Public Works Departments, obtained quotes for materials, and raised funds for the installation of the replacement barrier railings, and

WHEREAS, quotes were obtained from four lumber supply firms, and despite Pacific Redwood Products not having the lowest quote, they offered old-growth, reclaimed Redwood which would have an expected lifespan of 40 to 50 years, double that of pressure-treated Fir as quoted by the other firms, thus offering the overall "Best Value" for the City; and

WHEREAS, having the City purchase these materials leverages having our Carmel Cares partners donate the full cost for the installation which is most advantageous to the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA DOES HEREBY:

Authorize a Purchase Order, in the amount of \$50,000 to Pacific Redwood Products, LLC, to purchase materials for the Scenic Pathway Barrier Rails Project.
