STEPPING UP HOMELESSNESS: THE NEED FOR STRATEGIC LEADERSHIP AND COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING" AND AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF RESPONSES TO THE PRESIDING JUDGE OF THE MONTERY COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Civil Grady Jury issued a report entitled "Who's in Charge? Stepping up Homelessness: The need for strategic leadership and comprehensive planning" on June 4, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Grand Jury has requested that the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea respond to all twelve findings and ten recommendations contained within the report; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with California Penal Code Section 933(c), the governing body of the agency must respond to the findings and recommendations within 90 days from issuance of the report.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA DOES HEREBY:

- 1. Adopt the proposed responses in Attachment 2 of the staff report as the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea's responses to the 2017-2018 Monterey County Civil Grand Jury Report entitled "Who's in Charge? Stepping up Homelessness: The need for strategic leadership and comprehensive planning".
- 2. Authorize the Mayor to sign the cover letter on behalf of the City Council.
- 3. Authorize the City Administrator to forward the cover letter and responses to the Presiding Judge of the Monterey County Superior Court.
