Thanks for everyone's work on the strategic priorities. Here are a few suggestions for Thursdays Workshop that we believe will crystallize everyone's expectation on each item.

- 1. Providing a completion time estimate on each project or program will be helpful. We suggest a new column labeled "completion target or estimate". And this field would include the estimated quarter and fiscal year....e.g. Q3 FY24/25 or Q1 FY26/26
- 2. Providing a "dependency" column would be beneficial. Example the Wireless Ordinance item would have "Coastal Commission" approval required or other project # or other considerations.
- 3. Subdivide some big items.
- * The Affordable Housing item, we'd like to see subdivided into the major sections. E.g. #4 a) Housing Element HCD Certification, 4 b) Draft Objective Design Standards, 4 c) Commercial Property Engagement Program, 4 d) City Property Programs ...etc.
- * And the same should apply to Design Traditions (#12) needs segmenting into Design Guidelines Approved Residential and Commercial, Landscape Ordinance, Design Review Board Defined or similar.

These two master projects we suggest too large to stay as single items.

- 4. We'd also suggest the Sunset North/South Lot explorations (#27) should be consolidated into the Housing Element master item (e,g. City Property).
- 5. Delete #28 which is included, and is duplicative, of #4.
