1. Approval of the minutes from the January 9, 2020 Regular Meeting

Vice Chair Saroyan moved to approve the minutes for the January 9, 2020 regular meeting, seconded by Commissioner Myers, and approved by the following votes:

PUBLIC HEARINGS

2. Application to permit the removal of two significant trees at Casanova 5 SE of 12th for the construction of a new garage.

Staff recommendation is to approve the removal of the 10" and 14" oaks for the construction of a new structure. The Commission should consider requiring compensation to the City of \$250 per tree for planting or the appraised value of the two trees for \$3,600.

Chris Teascher gave a brief presentation and would like approval for the Commission to permit the removal of two significant trees at Casanova 5 SE of 12th for the construction of a new garage.

Commissioners discussed the issue with the information given. Commissioner Myers motioned to approve the removal of two (2) oak trees, after the payment of the appraised value of \$3600.00. With the understanding that the \$3600.00 is put into the Forest Restoration fund. Seconded by Commissioner Mosley and approved by the following vote:

3. Application to permit the removal of significant trees at Mission 5 NW of Santa Lucia for construction of a new single family residence.

Staff recommendation is to approve the removal of trees associated with the house footprint that has the least damage to existing trees. Tree #13 should have strict root zone protections in place prior to any excavation or construction.

Claudio Ortiz gave a presentation on behalf of the applicant, and discussed the pros and cons of reconfiguring the proposed house on the existing, wooded lot.

Commissioners discussed the issue with the information given. Chair Caddell moved to approve, provided that the Turners move the structure so that it is no closer than 20 ft. to Tree #13. Approve the removal of tree #11 and #7, #8 and #9. Contingent on the Planning Department permit. To also contribute to the Forest Restoration Fund, equivalent to the value of the trees and determined by the City Forester. Seconded by Commissioner Berling, followed by the following vote:
