A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MONTEREY COUNTY CONVENTION AND VISITORS BUREAU FOR DESTINATION MARKETING FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2022 TO JUNE 30, 2023 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,010

WHEREAS, transient occupancy tax and sales and use tax contribute to the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea's revenue sources and are heavily influenced by tourism; and

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Convention and Visitors Bureau possesses specialized knowledge and benefits from economy of scale in advertising and other marketing efforts in order to promote tourism within the Monterey Peninsula region and the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Carmel Municipal Code, contracts of \$25,000 or more require Council approval, and

WHEREAS, a true copy of the Agreement with the Monterey County Convention and Visitors Bureau for Destination Marketing for the Term of July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023 is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA DOES HEREBY:

Authorize the City Administrator to execute an agreement with the Monterey County Convention and Visitors Bureau for destination marketing for the term of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 in an amount not to exceed \$200,010.
