A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH WALD, RUHNKE & DOST ARCHITECTS FOR A FEE NOT TO EXCEED \$89,115 TO PREPARE A FUNCTIONAL PROGRAM REPORT AND SCHEMATIC DESIGN FOR THE EXPANDED SCOPE OF THE POLICE BUILDING RENOVATION AND RESILIENCE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the police building was constructed in 1967; and

WHEREAS, this facility requires modernization to accommodate current technology and improvements to maintain police functionality; and

WHEREAS, in June 2019, the City Council adopted the FY2019/20 Budget and Capital Improvement Plan, which included the Police Building Renovation Project in the amount of \$1,000,000; and

WHEREAS, in June 2020, the City Council postponed the Project due to the economic uncertainties of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department Renovation Project continues to be a high priority of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, in January 2022, the City Council provided direction to bring back the Project as an amendment to the FY2021/22 Capital Improvement Plan with a \$2.0-million dollar budget due to inflation in the construction industry; and

WHEREAS, \$1.3 million was added to the Project budget in the FY 2022/23 Capital Improvement Plan Budget to reflect additional scoping into the Project, as well as the re-analysis of regulatory requirements to comply with the 2022 Building Codes; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the additional desired project elements and new Building Code requirements, the project's current functional scope and cost estimate require update and revalidation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMEL BY-THE-SEA DOES HEREBY:

Authorize the City Administrator to execute a Professional Services Agreement with Wald, Ruhnke & Dost Architects for a fee not-to-exceed \$89,115 to prepare a Functional Program Report and Schematic Design for the expanded scope of the Police Building Renovation and Resilience Improvements Project.
