

Since I moved to the area in the early 1990's, I have had a powerful interest in preserving the historic resources and character of Carmel-by-the-Sea. Having served for many years previously on the HRB and as its Chair, it has been an honor to work with the Board, City staff, and the community. I find working with property owners who are upgrading their homes and buildings and make them functional for them into the future using adaptive reuse and modifications per the Secretary of the Interior's Standards is especially rewarding and gratifying. Incentivizing ongoing maintenance, upkeep and usability of historic resources is the best way to preserve their significance into the future.

Please list any relevant qualifications or experience you possess that would enhance the mission and goals of the board(s) or commission(s) for which you are applying:

I have been practicing architecture in Carmel-by-the-Sea since the 1990's, so it has been my vocation to work with and develop a deep understanding of the character of Carmel-by-the-Sea and this context. Not only have done projects in proximity to historic resources, but I've worked on several restorations of and sensitive modifications to significant homes and buildings in the City. I think it is critical, as well, to have talented architects on the HRB (not to mention the Planning Commission). Not only is it possible for us to interpret the documents/drawings which describe the projects that come before the board with a high degree of accuracy to help make better decisions which are in the best interest of the community, but it allows us to have more empathy for the applicants and designers who come before the board, as well as, the ability to offer helpful suggestions on how to move things forward. I feel having this balanced perspective is important for the Board and City in treating applicants with fairness and respect. Obviously, my other relevant qualification is my many years experience previously being a member of the HRB. I believe my return will add to the institutional memory of the board and can be extremely helpful as the Historic Context Statement is continued to be updated and the 'Design Traditions' project is being worked on.
